

NAF Festival of the Horse Challenge (Combined Show Jumping and Cross Country)

This competition is a test of the ability of a pony/horse and rider to negotiate a show jumping course together with a piece of hunting country at a fair pace. The course consists of 7-10 show jumps followed immediately by 8-15 cross-country fences. The whole competition will be timed. The show jumping and cross-country phases will be separately timed. In the event of a tie, total marks will be considered in the following order: **1. Lowest total penalties 2. Fastest SJ time 3. Nearest to XC time allowed (if still equal, preference given to nearest OVER time allowed).**

Section A classes are for BRC qualifiers only.

Section B classes are open to all riders, whether BRC members or not.

Max Fence height : SJ 0.85m (to be ridden at speed of 325mpm)
XC 0.85m (to be ridden at speed of 450mpm)

Horses or ponies not to have any BE points

Class 2 Junior Pairs

Max Fence height: SJ 0.85m (to be ridden at speed of 325mpm.)

The SJ phase will be run as a pairs relay. The XC will include up to 3 dressing fences.

Horses or ponies not to have won more than 20 BE points.

Class 3 Senior Novice

Max height of fences: SJ 0.85m (to be ridden at speed of 325pm)
XC 0.85m (to be ridden at speed of 450mpm)

Open to riders aged 18 or over on 1st January 2010.

Class 4 Senior Pairs

Max height of fences: SJ 0.85m (to be ridden at speed of 325pm.)
XC 0.85m (to be ridden at speed of 450mpm)

The SJ phase will be run as a pairs relay. The XC will include up to 3 dressing fences.

Horses or ponies not to have won more than 20 BE points.

Class 5 Junior Open

Max height of fences: SJ 1.00m (to be ridden at speed of 325pm.)
XC 1.00m (to be ridden at speed of 490mpm)

Horses or ponies not to have won more than 20 BE points.

Class 6 Senior Open

Max height of fences: SJ 1.00m (to be ridden at speed of 325pm.)
XC 1.00m (to be ridden at speed of 490mpm)

Section A Entries:

Preliminary entries should be sent to the BRC office **by Friday 26th March 2010.**

Detailed entries to be sent to the Entries Secretary by **Friday 9th April 2010.**

Legible copies of Flu Vaccination Certificates must be submitted with all Qualifier entries, and the original Flu Vaccination Certificates shown to the Competition Secretary before number cloths will be issued. Times will be posted to Team managers.

Section B Entries: to be sent direct to the Entries Secretary to arrive no later than **Friday 9th April 2010**, together with SAE for times. It is strongly recommended that horses and ponies competing in the Section B classes are inoculated against equine influenza.

No entries will be accepted unless in writing with the correct entry fee enclosed.

Substitutions:

In the event of withdrawals from the BRC team qualifiers, substitutions will be allowed. The deadline for complex substitutions will be 6.00pm on **Friday 16th April**. Late simple substitutions may be made at the time teams and individuals are declared. A complex substitution is one where teams are re-arranged or horse and rider combinations are moved from one team to another. Simple substitutions are ones where a horse and rider replaces the withdrawn one in the same team and position.

Course Walking :

the SJ/ XC course will be available for walking from 3pm on **Saturday 17th April**

Rules and Conditions

All classes will run in accordance with BRC Official Rules 2009, and rules specific to this competition can be seen at www.britishridingclubs.org.uk or www.southwilt ridingclub.org.uk
BRC Official Rules can also be obtained from the BHS bookshop

It is the responsibility of all competitors to familiarise themselves with the competition rules and, in the case of all BRC qualifying classes, to comply with the BRC equine flu vaccination rules.

1. Any objection must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of said offence and accompanied by a deposit of £20. The deposit is returnable only if the objection is upheld.
2. The whole competition is to be ridden in cross country dress as per Appendix 4 of BRC rules.
3. Everyone mounted – whether competing or not – must wear a hard hat to at least minimum standard, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination. Hats marked with EN1384, PAS015 or prefixed with ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard allowed. Recommended hats should carry the quality assurance stamp of Kitemark or SEI. American standard SNELL E2001 and Australian/New Zealand standard SNZ 3838 1998 are also acceptable. Where a hat is of skullcap style, this must be worn with a coloured silk. **Fixed peaks are not permitted.**
4. Body protectors to BETA standard Class 3 (purple label) are obligatory. It is recommended that they are worn outside clothing.
5. Medical armbands must be worn on the arm NOT on the leg.
6. Long hair should be worn in a hair net or secured in such a way that it does not hang lower than the shoulder line.
7. Horses and ponies may only be ridden once in each class, with the exception of the pairs when the horse/pony may compete once in either of the relevant open or novice competition and once in the pairs competition.
8. A horse or pony may compete from 1 January in the year that it becomes 5 years old. If ridden by an adult in the Area qualifier it must be at least 14hh.
9. If a horse or pony is deemed unfit or unwell the organisers have the right to have the animal removed from the showground.
10. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, alter classes, judges, times or any other published information. Refund of entry fees less £2 will be made only on production of a vet's or doctor's certificate, except in the event of cancellation where all fees will be refunded less 15%.
11. No stopwatches or any other receiving, recording, transmitting or monitoring device may be used by a competitor during any phase of the competition.

It shall be deemed a condition of entry that the organisers, landowners and his agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage to competitors, onlookers, their property caused on the showground.

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY: The organiser of this event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and shall obey the instructions of the organiser, and all officials and stewards.
